
We need to generate income to sustain the magazine and leave a beneficial legacy for any strategic alliances we partner with.

(Jami' at-Tirmidhi 3358, Book 47, Hadith 410)

3. Transform my prayer

Saying of Allahu Akbar, known as Takbirat-ul-Ihram. But what exactly does Allahu Akbar mean? What are we saying?

Interestingly, I've seen people give three slightly different answers to this question...

A quick Google Images search also showed the same:



Which one is the correct meaning?

- a) God is great
- b) God is greater
- c) God is greatest

What do you think?

(answer before you read the next line)

If you answered b, you are correct!

Allahu Akbar literally means: God is greater.

The question that naturally follows is:

Greater... than what?

The statement is intentionally left open-ended.

Why?

Because no matter who or what you fill in the blank with... God is still greater!

God is greater... than your concerns and your worries.

God is greater... than you and everything you can think of.

God is greater... than the problems that you have. He is the One who can help you get through them and overcome them.

God is greater... than anyone or anything else, due to which you may miss the Salah sometimes.

By saying Allahu Akbar, we remind ourselves about who Allah is, and who we are in relation to Him.

That's why I call this phrase: the Declaration of Dependence.

We are declaring God's Greatness / Independence, and admitting our own dependence and reliance on Him.

It's such a significant phrase - it symbolizes and captures our core belief.

-Now, the Takbirat-ul-Ihram (saying Allahu Akbar specifically at the beginning of the prayer) is not just any Takbir...

It's the opening, sacred declaration of God's greatness.

The word Ihram, which you may recognize from the context of umrah / hajj, means:

- to make sacred, or enter into a sacred space
- to be in a state where certain things become haram, or impermissible.

That's why, once you start the prayer...

- you don't talk to anyone else
- you don't eat or drink
- you don't move around
- you don't even look around

All of the above are normally permissible, but they become impermissible (haram) in the prayer...

...because you are entering into a sacred meeting with God.

It's like the analogy we referred to in a previous email of the peasant / farmer who's coming off the land to meet with the king.

He's disheveled and dusty, so he cleans and washes himself up outside, and gets himself in order.

Then, he proceeds to open the doors to the palace and present himself to his majesty, the king.

The pushing open of the doors to enter the sacred palace is like the moment we raise and fold our hands while saying Allahu Akbar to begin the prayer.

-So from now on, when you say Allahu Akbar...

Say it with presence and with power. Say it like you really mean it and believe it.

And of course, align your saying of the words with a symbolic, meaningful and purposeful gesture of raising and folding your hands...

...because what we want to avoid is (a) a movement of the hands which is devoid of meaning, and (b) a statement of Allahu Akbar which we're not actually registering.



However, I wish to gently challenge this notion, encouraging you to explore beyond the usual resolutions you may set at the end of each Islamic/Gregorian year.

Hence, when we reach significant milestones within the Islamic year, we shouldn't simply overlay secular approaches to goal-setting and new year resolutions. Instead, we should develop spiritually-intelligent ways to formulate these resolutions that align with our faith principles and values.

Here are some steps I suggest you consider now that we are in 1445 AH

Step 1: Download our Annual Review Worksheet.

Last Ramadan, we created this annual review work-

which was designed to review your year from one Ramadan to the next.

However, the same tool can be used to review your Islamic year.download it and watch the video on how to use it (you can skip all the Ramadan references).

Step 2: Sincere Repentance

Once you complete the worksheet - take a moment to sincerely repent for all the sins committed throughout the year. Take a moment to express remorse over your wrongdoings and ask Allah to forgive you. If you did harm to people or cut off people - use the opportunity of a new Islamic year to seek their forgiveness and reconnect with people.

Step 3: Express Gratitude

Along with repentance - express heartfelt gratitude and thanks to Allah SWT for the innumerable blessings He has bestowed upon you.


Part of being grateful to Him is to express gratitude to the people in your life who've helped you along this year as well. Go down your WhatsApp contact list and send messages or voice-notes to various people who've had an impact on your year, thank them for all they did for you this year.

Step 4: Set intentions for the upcoming New Islamic year



And indeed, for you in grazing livestock is a lesson. We give you drink from what is in their bellies – between excretion and blood – pure milk, palatable to drinkers." (Surat an-Nahl, 16:66)

"There are amazing lessons in God's creation, and this verse points us to one of them. Allah shows us how that sometimes beneficial things are hidden between things that are undesirable or cause harm. From the inside of an animal – where there is blood and things we would not think of touching or consuming in a raw state – we get something as pure as milk, that brings benefit to us. I want to reflect on two things here:



1) Allah shows us through this example that in the midst of discomfort or unwanted events, there can be benefits. But that benefit can only be brought about if one truly looks, reflects and takes the steps to extract it. Look for your ease within your hardship; your comfort in discomfort; your blessings in difficulty. God creates both things in one being.

2) There are lessons in how God has created this world. "Tafakkur" (pondering and reflecting) is considered one of the great acts of worship. It connects us to Allah and enables us to understand and use our minds, which we are commanded to do in the Qur'an. Through this, we can truly understand that Allah has created the world in a certain way and take comfort in that."
